And got washed away down a drain!



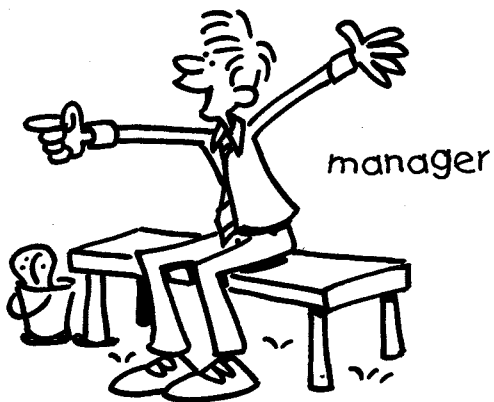
Mary had a little lamb,

I'll try kicking it over the fence!"

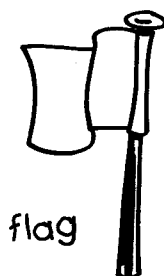
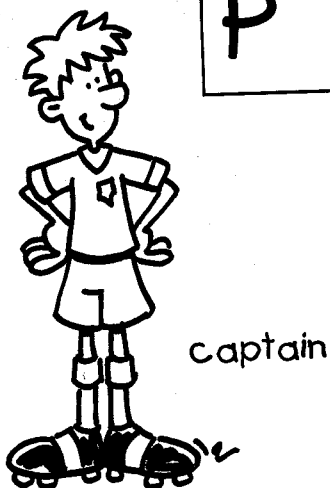
