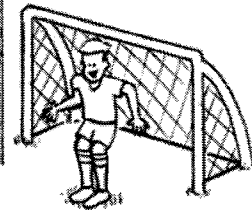
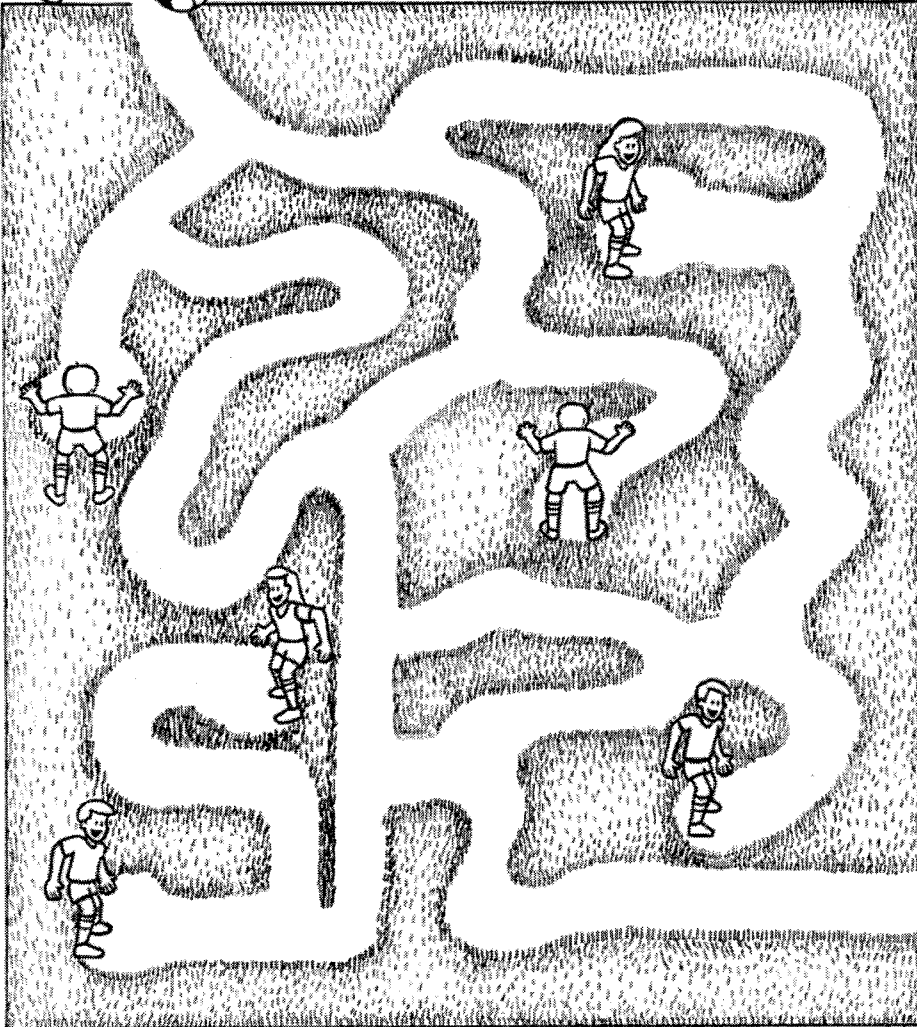




1. The Maze Dribble

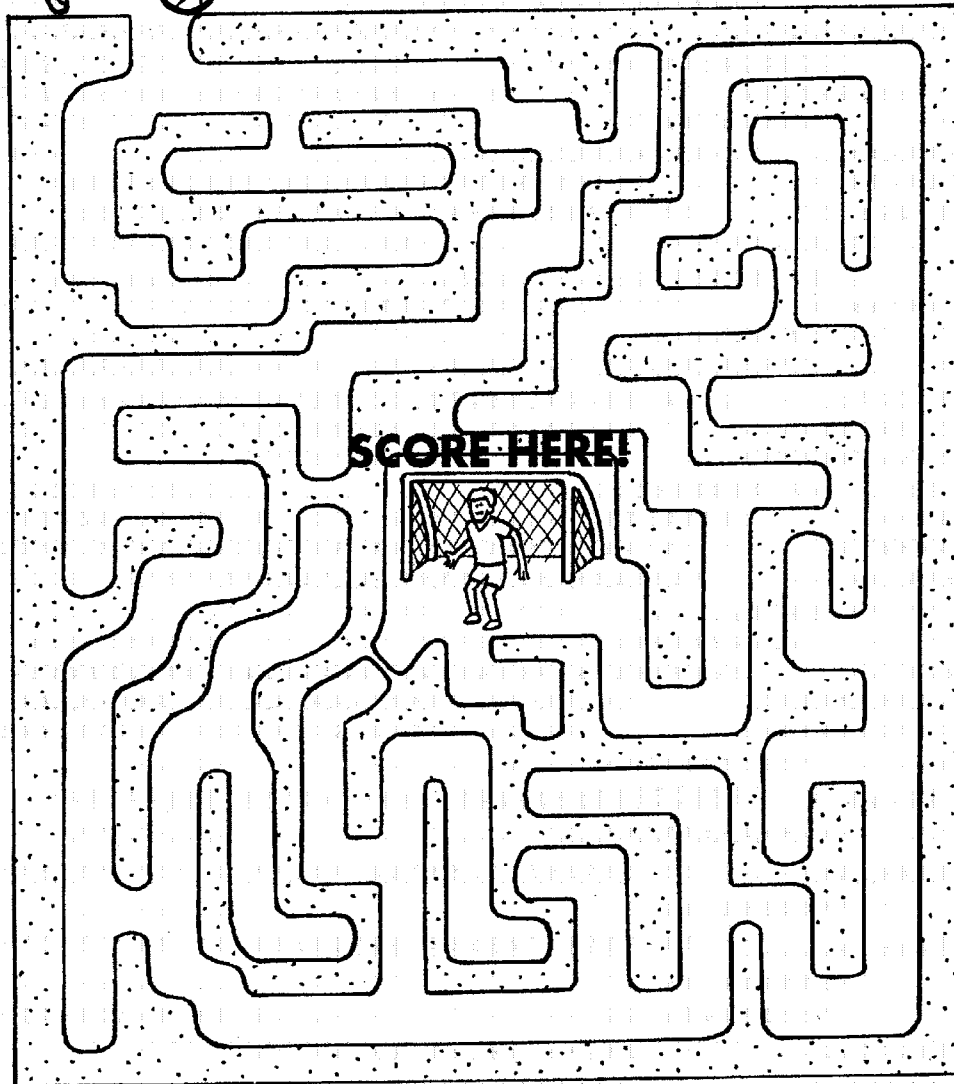

Once you go wrong, too late! No goal! So be careful.

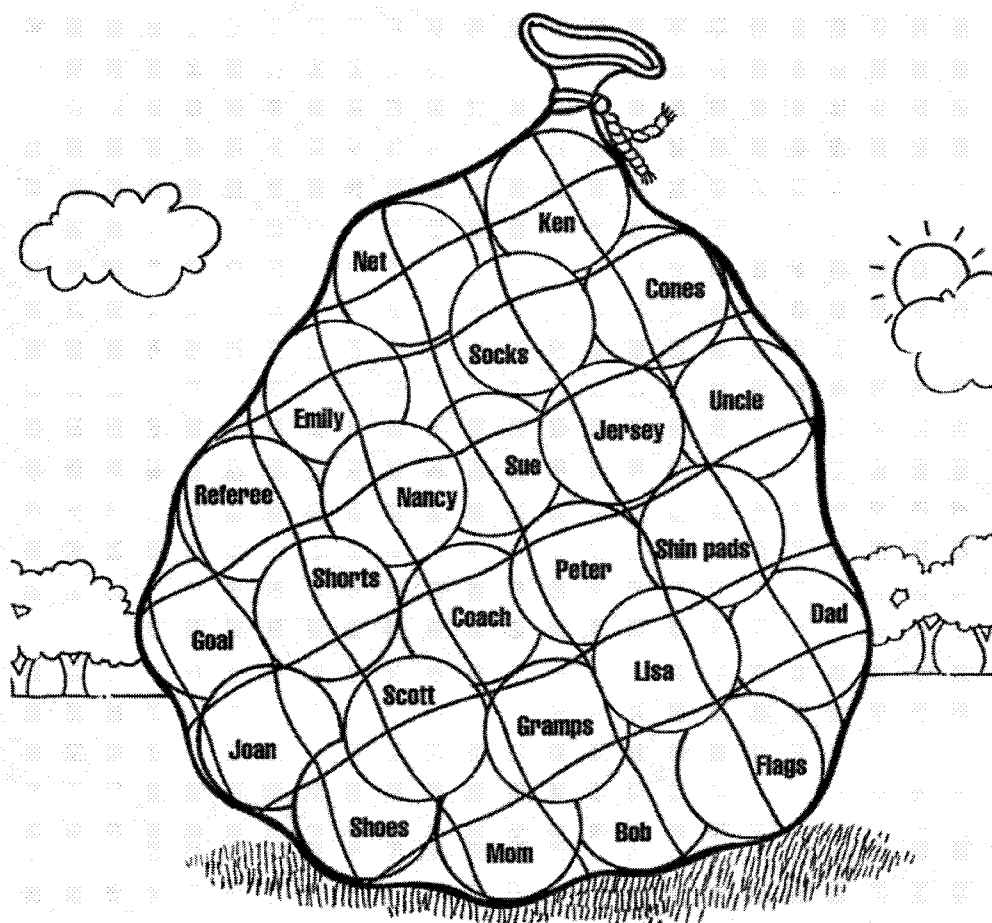
3. A Bag Full of Soccer Balls

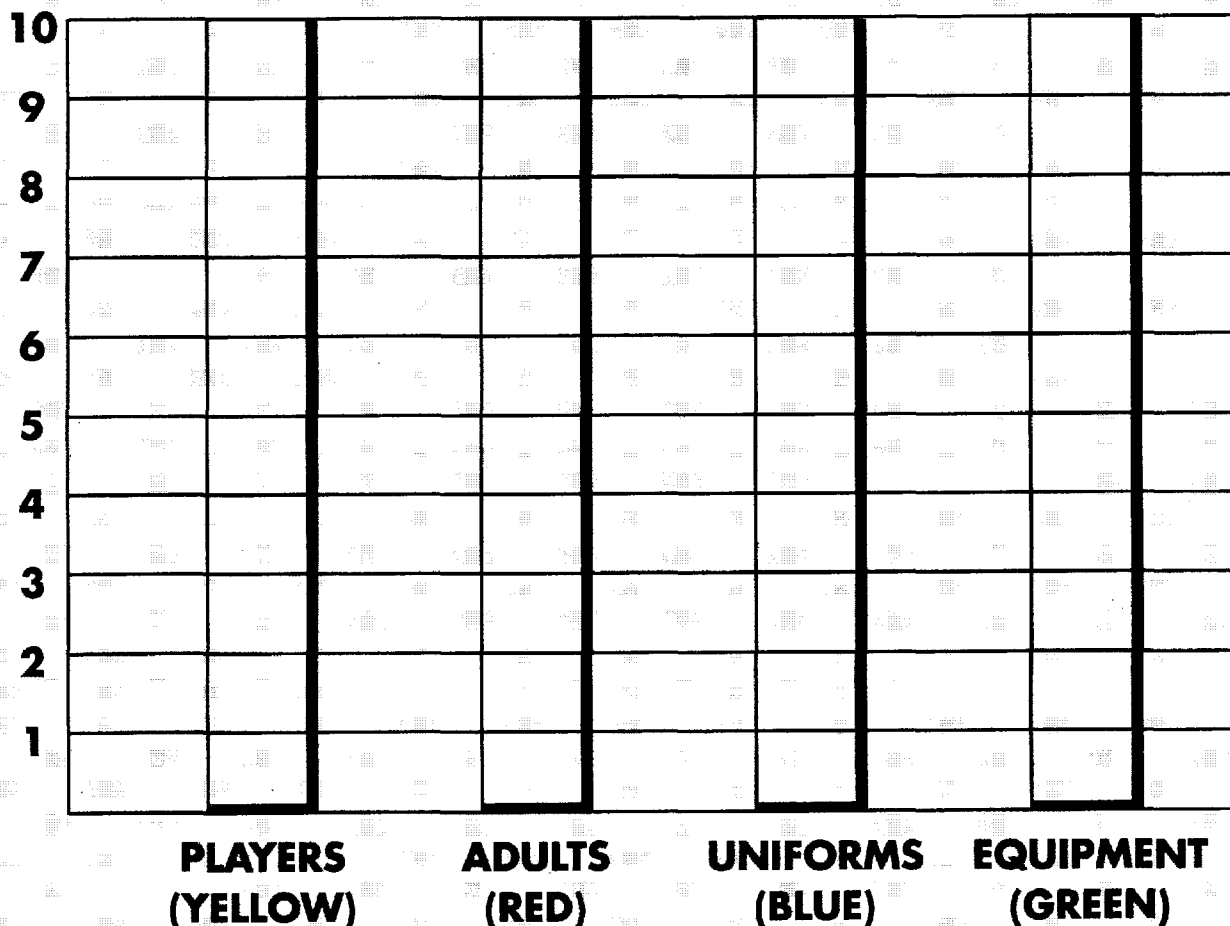

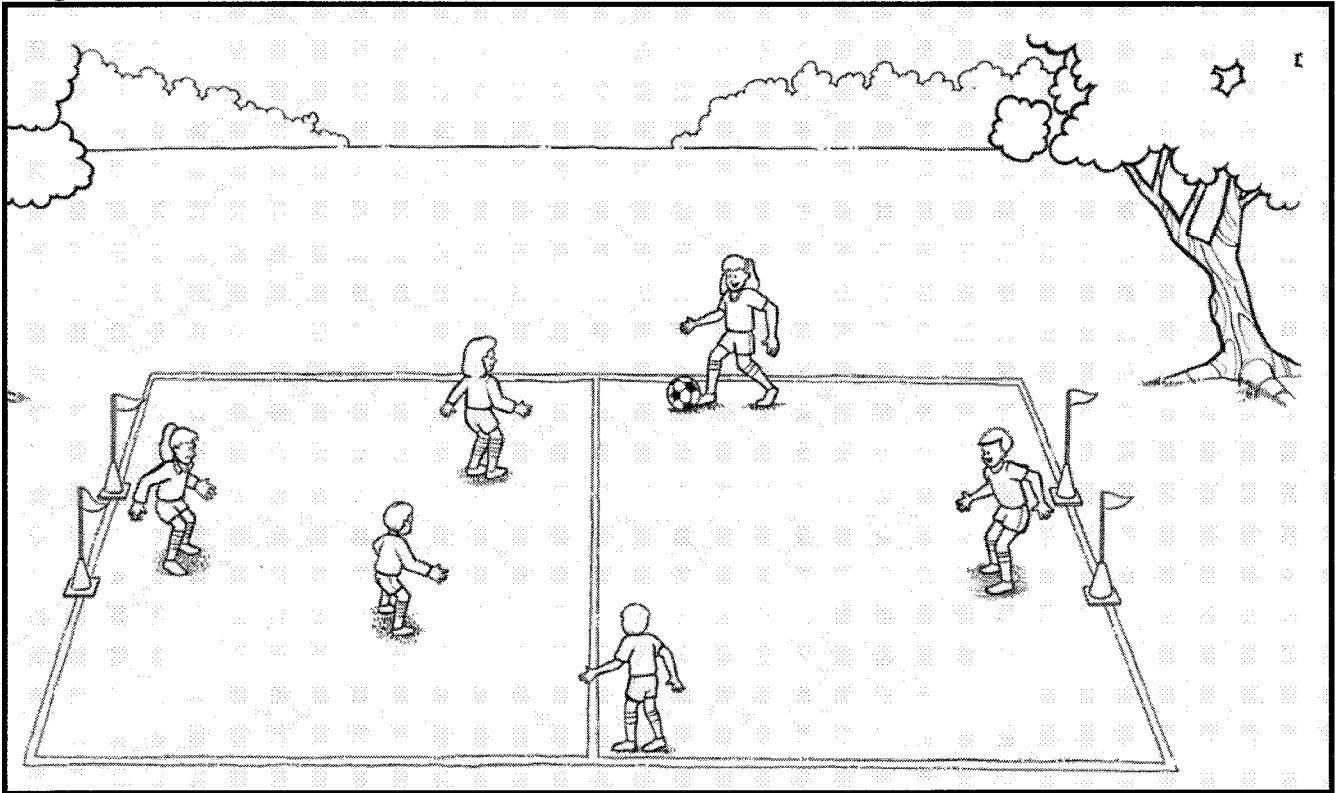

5. Two's Company, Three's a Team – and a Triangle

The TRIANGLE is a great shape to know if you're a soccer player. It can help you score, attack and defend. In 3-a-side soccer, the triangle is used a lot. After all, a triangle does have 3 sides.

Draw 3 straight lines to join the players who have long sleeves.

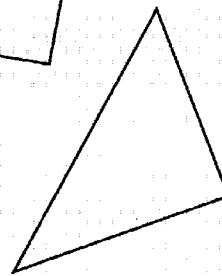
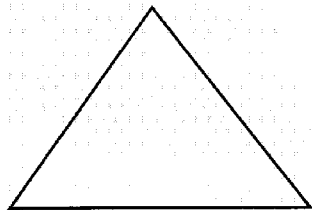
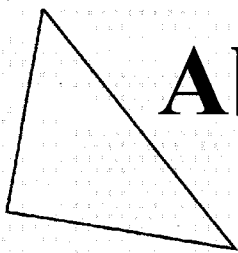
It should form another triangle.

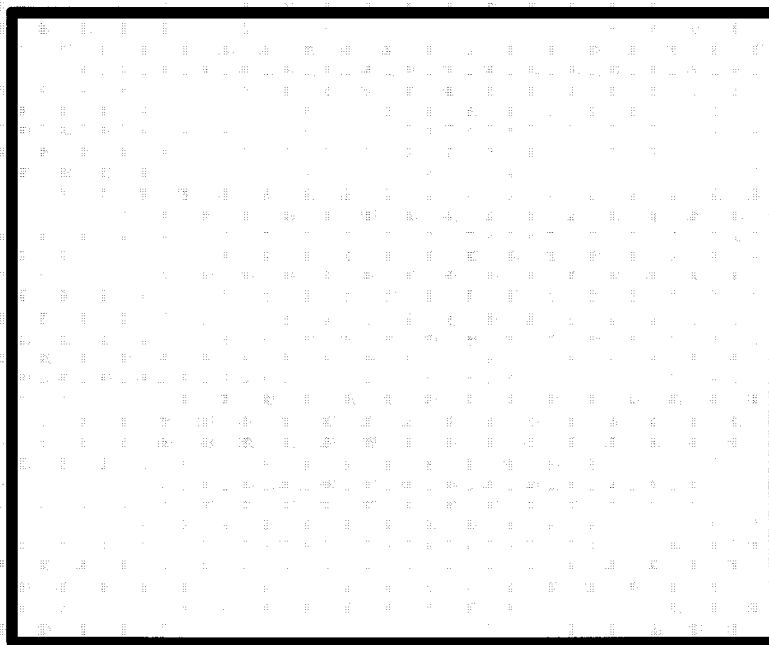

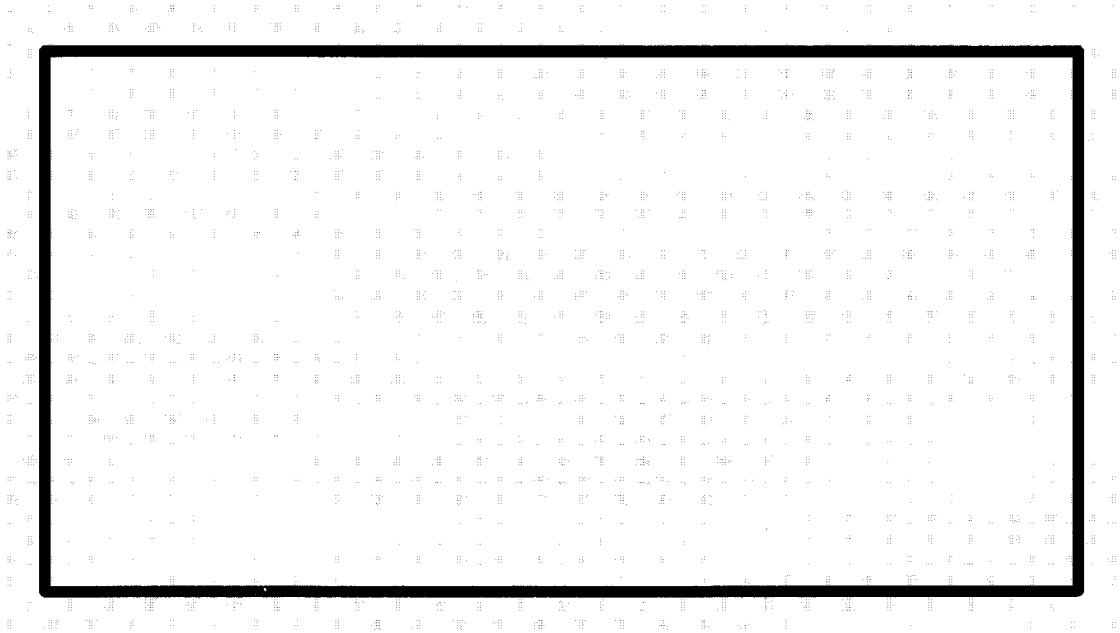

7. Triangles and Rectangles

When you're finished, color it to make a great design.

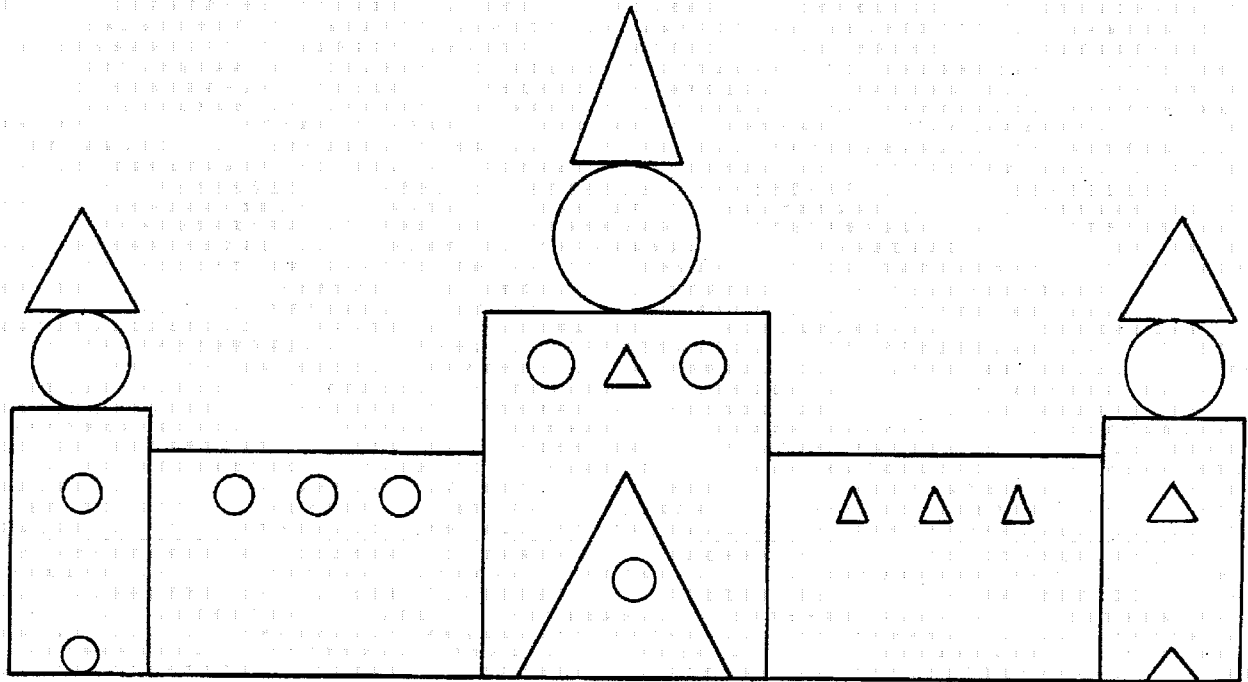
8. A Triangle/Circle Search

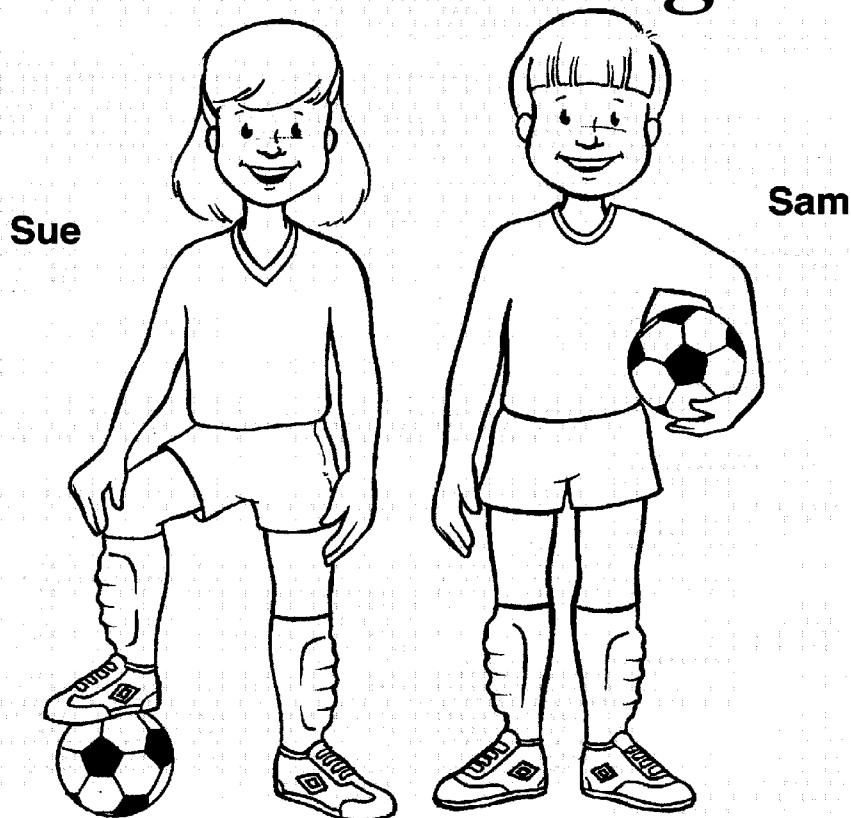

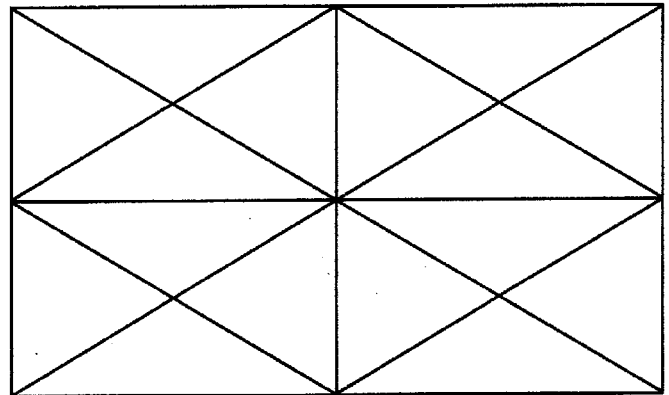

13. Great Save



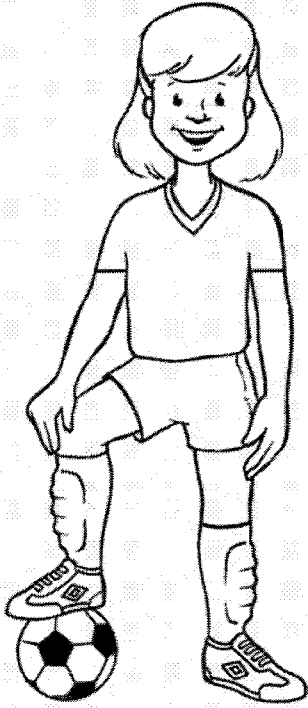
You can see 3 players in the picture. Color their uniforms.

14. Handling the Ball



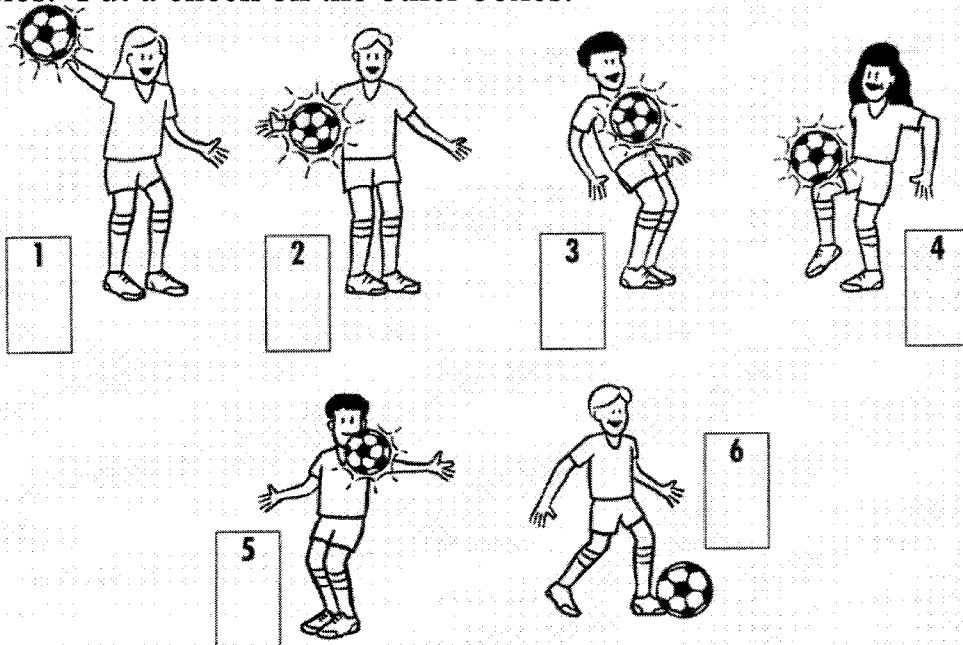
When you play soccer, you usually move the ball with your foot. That's why in many countries, soccer is called FOOTball.

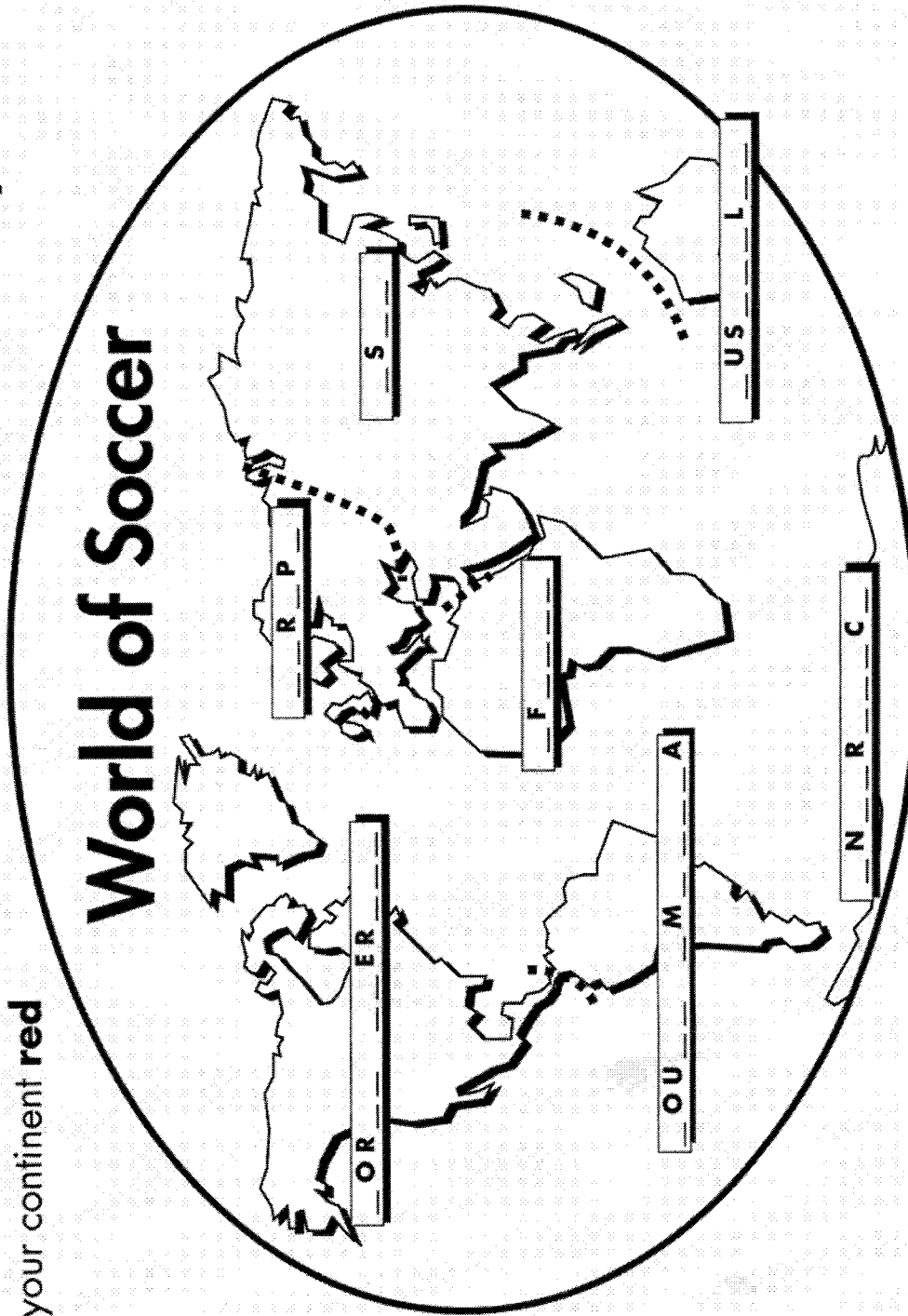

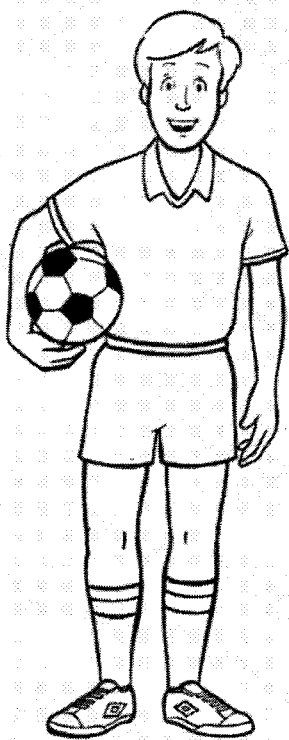

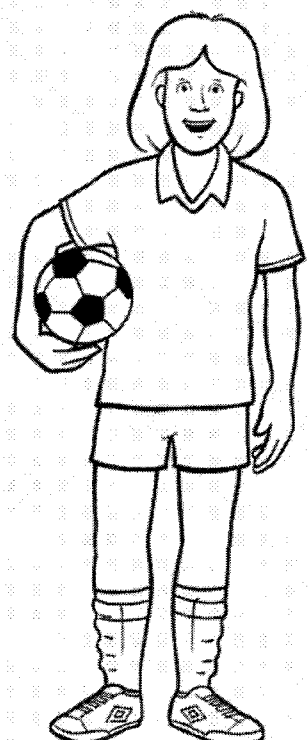
